


CYPHER 1

WORKING NOTES: 1 - PRICE FILE UPDATES & VERSION ENHANCEMENTS.

A) SET UP

- These are now available **only** over the internet on a download basis.
- In **Cypher 1/System/User Defaults**, (pic1) each user can set the frequency (in days) at which an update test is performed.
- This enables you to restrict the test to one **nominated** user or allow a **group** of users to run the test.

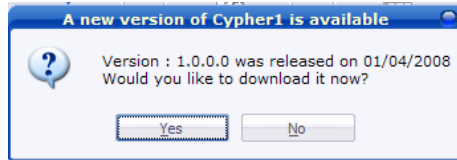

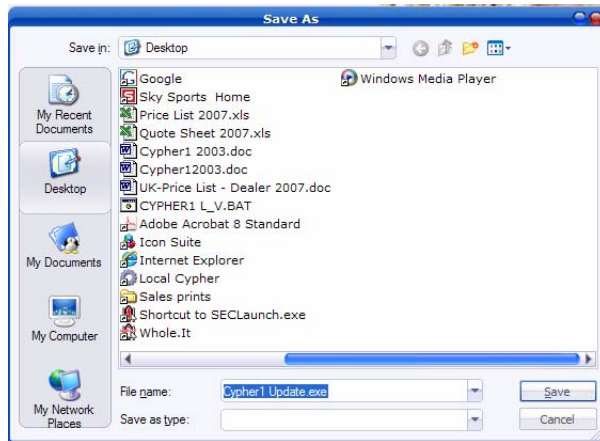
- Here the **Download Test Days** is set to '0' (zero) – this will perform a check every time Cypher 1 is opened.
- The **Download User Name** and **Password** fields will be blank on installation – these details can be obtained from SEC Support Dept. and are dependant on both an active **Standing Order** for the Price File Updates and a **valid Software Support Contract** for the Version Enhancements.

B) LOADING A VERSION ENHANCEMENT

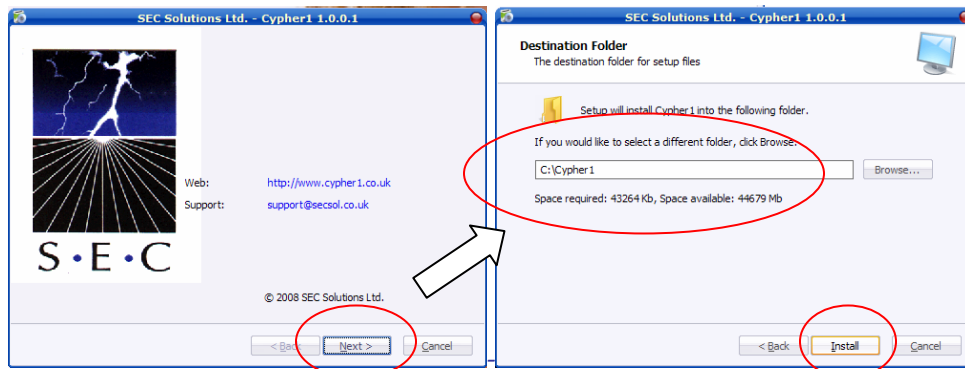
Once a **Version Enhancement Update** has been identified you will see this message;



- Click **Yes**:



- Save this small file to your desktop – you will need it to **open and apply** latest versions as they become available.
- When you are ready, (this cant be performed with Cypher 1 open) launch the **Cypher 1 Update Program**;



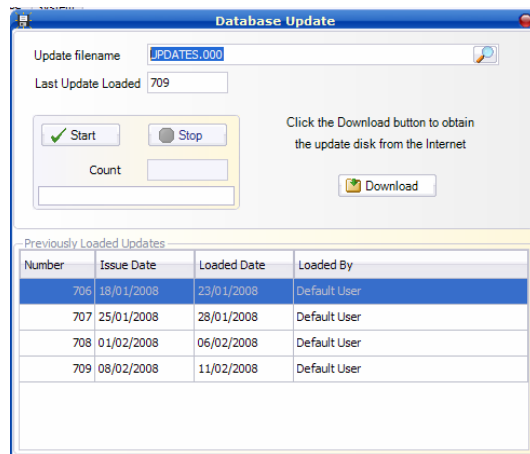
- Choose the **path to install to**, use the **Browse** button to find the **Cypher 1** directory or ask your **Network Administrator** then click on **Install**.
- The **Version Enhancement** **and** any associated files will install themselves.
- Click on **Finish**.

C) LOADING A PRICE FILE UPDATE

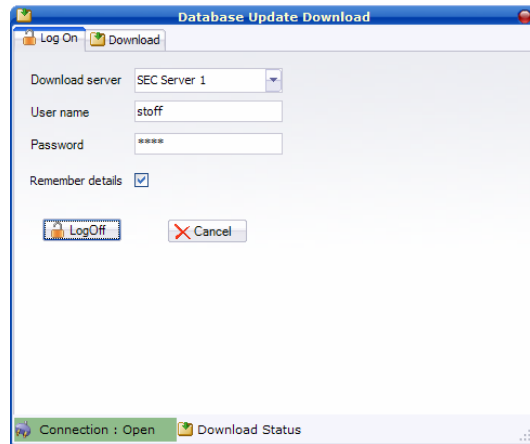
Once a **Price File** Update has been identified you will see this message;

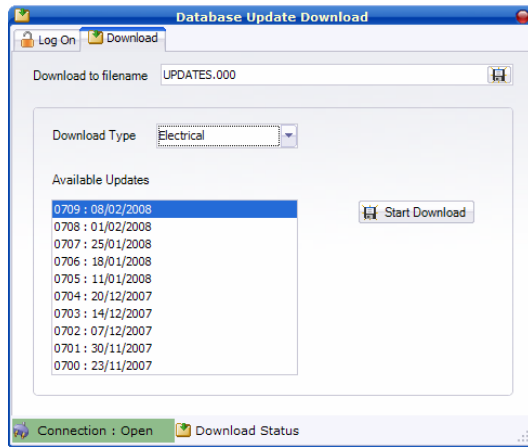
- Go to Database/Load Update from the front screen, this is what you will see;



- Previously loaded Updates will be listed here together with a note of the last number you loaded.
- Click on the Download button, complete the Log On screen and click Log On;



- Click on the **Download** tab, leave the filename as UPDATES.000, and select your Database type (Electrical or Mechanical) from the drop down list.
- The latest available download will be shown highlighted at the top of a list;



- *Click on **Start Download**.*
- *The Update will begin automatically and the Update Notes will be displayed so the **product count** can be seen*
